Enterprise Architecture Using UAF: UAF Overview, EA Guide for UAF, and EA Process for UAF

Abstract:

The Unified Architecture Framework (UAF) is a 5th generation framework published by the Object Management Group (OMG). The UAF Profile provides a SysML-based language for modeling an enterprise based on the UAF Domain Metamodel. When using UAF, the models will be DoDAF-compliant, or you can create fit-for-purpose views. An Enterprise Architecture (EA) Guide is being developed to become part of the UAF standard to help people better utilize the features of the UAF modeling approach. This talk will give an introduction to the EA Guide for UAF along with the underlying process, as well as provide an overview of the UAF Domain Metamodel and Profile.
